Dear Administrators and Art Teachers:

The Wyandotte Street Art Fair Committee is pleased to inform you that we have **extended the deadline to March 19<sup>th</sup> for the Wyandotte Street Art Fair Dan Drotar Scholarship**. The award has also been **raised to \$1000**. Funds for the scholarship were derived from the 2011 Art Fair Children's Emporium and Art Fair receipts. Each participating artist was encouraged to donate, for the Emporium, at least one item to be purchased by children, 12 years of age and under. The purpose of the Emporium is to create art appreciation for school-age children enabling them to purchase original art work at a low cost.

To be eligible, students (only Wyandotte residents, senior class student) must submit, by March 19, 2012, the following:

1. Application
2. A portfolio of works (5 minimum, 10 maximum)
3. Recommendation letters from one art teacher, two academic teachers and/or counselors, and one citizen.

Submissions can be dropped off at the Mayor's Office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of City Hall, 3131 Biddle Ave., Wyandotte, MI 48192.

The 2012 Wyandotte Street Art Fair Jury will judge the entries and scoring will be anonymous. The following are the Jury's criteria for evaluation and scoring entries on an objective basis. Please consider these concepts as you prepare your submittals.

1. Creativity: The artwork submitted demonstrates original thinking and expressive artistic perceptions.
2. Composition: The artwork demonstrates a unique and sensitive way of answering an artistic problem or illustrates the students' understanding and ability to interpret the elements of art and principles of design and that it is something that is makes a unique statement.
3. Technique: Artist demonstrates and artist quality and competency in using the medium to achieve the desired outcome.
4. Originality - It's okay for the art work to be started or generated by other mediums as some are. Works can not be replicated, copied or manipulated from photographs, from the internet or other published sources. It can get its frame of reference and stimulus, but it has to be in an original form. Inspiration can come from those other art forms. We will certainly allow and encourage students to use a number of mediums.

Entries must be art-oriented creative design in two-dimensional or three-dimensional form. Scholarship must be utilized within one year of award. The winner will be notified by April 2, 2012.
